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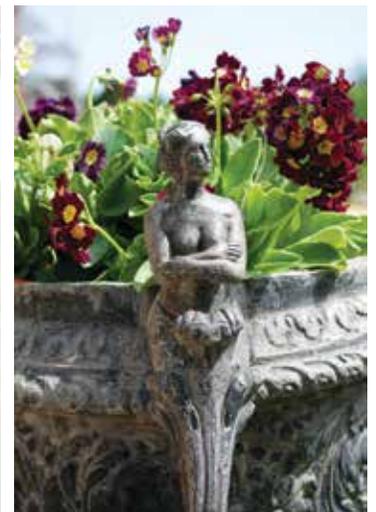

## ITINERARY:

29-JUNE	Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. (Airfare not included in package rate)
30-JUNE	After landing at London Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities before meeting your tour guide, who will welcome you to England. Travel west to visit Stonehenge, one of Britain's most celebrated monuments. Set on Salisbury Plain, Stonehenge is comprised of the remains of a double circle of monoliths, which dates from approximately 3000 BC. Continue to Bath for a tour of this elegant spa town, which has been famous for its natural hot springs for almost 2,000 years. Stop to visit the Roman Baths and the Pump Room, which dates from 1795, and is one of the most famous buildings in the country. After your visit, transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and settle into your room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner in the hotel restaurant.
01-JULY	Today, visit Stourhead Gardens to see the lush 18th century gardens filled with intriguing lakeside walkways and classical temples. Afterwards, drive to your hotel in Cardiff and check in. Once you settle in you will have some time on your own. After an independent dinner, see a performance at the Cardiff Open Air Theatre.
02-JULY	This morning, take a guided tour around Cardiff Castle. This castle dates from the 11th century but was extensively rebuilt in the 1860s with elaborate decorations throughout. Next, travel through Tintern before stopping at Veddew House Gardens for a visit. The garden is roughly 4 acres in total and the reflection pool is often considered a highlight. After your visit, drive to your hotel in Mickelton and check in. Tonight, dinner will be with your group at the hotel.
03-JULY	After breakfast, travel through the beautiful and hilly countryside of the Cotswolds. Here, the houses are mainly built of the local honey-colored stone and see quaint villages, which have remained almost unchanged for 200 years. Next, visit Hidcote Manor Garden, which is generally recognized as being one of the world's great gardens, and has been very influential on many garden designs. Continue on to visit Bourton House, an 18th century Manor House surrounding an award-winning garden. After your visit, head back to Mickleton, where you can relax or freshen up before dinner. Tonight, enjoy dinner at the Pudding Club in Mickleton, which of course will serve some of England's best English Pudding.
04-JULY	Leaving Mickleton, travel via Chipping Norton to Woodstock. Stop to visit Blenheim Palace, which is Britain's largest private house and also the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill. Continue on for a walking tour of Oxford to see some of the town's famous colleges such as Christchurch, Oxford University and New College. Also, view Oxford Canal, the Bridge of Sighs and the Story Museum. After your leisurely walk, drive to London, England's capital city and check into your hotel. Once you settle in, you are free for individual pursuits and dining.
05-JULY	Motor a short distance to Hampton Court Palace and spend much of the day at the Hampton Court Flower Show. See colorful floral displays, stunning gardens and have plenty of shopping opportunities in this remarkable setting. This evening, enjoy a dinner cruise along the River Thames. See some of London's best known sites such Houses of Parliament, London Bridge, Tower Bridge and the Millennium Dome.
06-JULY	Transfer to London Airport in good time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying across the Atlantic Ocean back to the United States.

If you are traveling with a child under 16 years of age and are not the legal parent, you are required by customs to carry a notarized statement granting permission from both the child's parents to enter Canada. If you are a single or married parent and are traveling as a single parent, you are required by customs to carry a notarized statement granting permission from the child's other parent to enter Canada. Any passenger without proper proof at boarding may be refused boarding. Non-U.S. citizens should consult their AAA Travel Counselor for appropriate visa requirements. **PLEASE BE ADVISED:** Proper documentation must be shown upon check-in prior to departure or boarding will be denied and no refunds given. Arrival and departure times are subject to change based on weather, traffic and border conditions. Pick up locations are subject to change based on parking availability. 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**ACTIVITY LEVELS:** Group travel requires a unique blend of adventuresome spirit, physical and mental alertness, and a capacity for accepting situations as they exist. To help you choose the AAA vacation that is best for you and to ensure the most efficient operation of our tours we feel our activity level scale located on the front of the brochure will help you select the pace that's right for you.

- 1 = Easy** – Very leisurely pace, minimal physical activity, stepping on and off the coach, and shorter touring days
- 2 = Moderately Easy** – Easy pace, some stairs and standing, three to four blocks of walking at a time on level terrains
- 3 = Active** – Moderate pace, good mobility needed, stairs and prolonged standing, includes city walking tours, some shorter and some longer days
- 4 = Moderately Challenging** – Fast pace, some strenuous activities, walking on varied terrain and up to two miles at a time
- 5 = Challenging** – Vigorous pace, frequent strenuous activities, extensive walking and longer touring days
